All patients should be admitted to hospital for their safety and further investigations with imaging. There is a threat to vision in all cases of Papilloedema, but particularly IIH, in which may deteriorate very quickly.

If imaging can be undertaken quickly, patients can be managed as a daycase for Lumbar puncture and pressure measurement.
