1	Ambulance Service/Primary Care	<p>Know</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The signs and symptoms of potential anaphylaxis (21) To transfer to the ED in all cases (21) <p>Be able to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make an initial assessment and treatment based on an ABCDE approach (21) Administer IM injectable adrenaline (21,22,24,25) if indicated To identify and remove the trigger (21) if possible Provide other treatment (21) if necessary
