









# Paediatric Trigger List



## Admission / Access / Discharge:

- More than 4 patients on Assessment pathway
- Readmission within 30 days for the same or related condition (unless open access)
- Admission of babies under 28 days old from Community Midwifery Team
- Postponed surgery—lack of theatre space, lack of equipment, high occupancy
- High Risk room not available for CAMHS patient
- Delayed discharge for CAMHS patients (no Tier 4 placements)
- Delayed discharge due to Children's Services input / referral
- Non-medical admission (admission for social reasons, lack of appropriate accommodation etc)

# **Bed Management:**

- Suspended admissions —staffing / dependency / occupancy
- Transfer of children due to lack of appropriate bed space
- Pregnant teenagers admitted with obstetric problems

#### **Documentation / Patient Records:**

- Missed appointments / referrals
- Delay in parents / GP receiving EDS of 3 days plus
- Inaccurate incomplete documentation leading to delayed management

### **Treatment Related:**

- Delay in clinical management leading to moderate harm
- Unexpected deterioration or Transfer to PICU
- Return to theatre
- Medication issues—prescription errors, documentation, omitted doses, lack of availability of medication
- Absconding children/young people
- MRSA / MSSA / E.coli / Klebsiella bacteraemia
- Extravasation—resulting in a phlebitis score of 3-5
- Development of pressure sores
- Any unexpected death of child / young person under 18 years old.
