- **1.** A full history should be taken and documented within the medical notes directly or on assessment form signed and dated
- 2. Clinical examination should be performed, documented, signed and dated within the medical notes i.e. assessment sheet, clinic letter to referrer.
- 3. APPs will formally be IRMER defined non-medical referrers.
- **4.** Refer to protocol WAHT-KD-024 p37 for indications for radiographic examination <u>http://whitsweb/KeyDocs/KeyDocs/DownloadFile/1980</u>
- **5.** Discuss request with Consultant Radiologist and /or Consultant within specialist area i.e. Orthopaedics, Spinal and Pain.
- 6. Radiological examinations undertaken at Kidderminster Treatment Centre and Alexandra Hospital, Redditch, within spinal clinics will have written reports produced by a Consultant Radiologist under IRMER regulations.
- **7.** All other radiological examinations NOT formally reported will be reviewed by a Consultant and/or Specialist Registrar with the APP documenting the findings and reviewer in the medical notes, or corresponding PACS note section.
- 8. Review of any formally reported x-ray images will be undertaken either independently or with the support of the radiology or medical staff
- **9.** The APP is accountable for professional development in maintaining and extending their knowledge relating to:
  - Requesting & reviewing radiological investigations
  - Development of Service Provision
  - The Royal College of radiologist Guidelines

- **10.** Any **Urgent Findings** related to non-musculoskeletal pathology, for example, suspected malignancy, aneurysm, cystic lesions will be urgently reported to the patient's GP Alexandra Back Pain Assessment Clinic (ABPAC) & Back Pain Clinic (KTC) and/or lead Consultant if the Advanced Physiotherapy Practitioner is working within a Pain and/or Orthopaedic specialty team.
