Nursed exposed at all times (nappy free) *except during phototherapy treatment (apply nappy) Apply Barrier Lollipop daily prophylactically for NAS babies

Prevent


Normal skin/no skin damage



- Cleanse area with water at every change
- Inspect skin for signs of damage

Protect

Red skin, unbroken



- At every change wash area with warm water
- **Apply Barrier Cream**

Repair/Restore

Skin broken/Excoriation

Mild



Severe



- At every change wash area with warm water
- **Apply Barrier** Lollipop once daily & Barrier Cream at every change
- At every change wash area with warm water
- Apply an Enzyme Alginogel PRN or at every cleanse (Apply 0.5mm (£1 coin) thickness to area)

Dependant on availability the following products may be used: Barrier Cream & Lollipop – Mediderma S, Cavilon or Sorbaderm. Enzyme Alginogel – Flaminal Forte.
